BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Brookland Valley is located along Caves Road, in the heart of the premium wine region of Margaret River, Western Australia. A truly beautiful estate with the Wilyabrup Brook as a breathtaking backdrop to all that Brookland Valley has to offer. The picturesque property spans 52ha, consisting of vineyards established in 1983 planted to Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sauvignon Blanc and Merlot.

TASTING NOTES

Pale straw with a green hue, this wine displays aromas of melon, white peach and a touch of struck match complexity, balanced with gentle French oak. The palate is full flavoured, with initial sweet fruit coupled with an abundance of melon, toasted hazelnuts and a touch of marmalade. The wine is beautifully balanced by crisp acidity and fine oak.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

The 2006/07 growing season was warm and dry compared to average - and total rainfall for the growing season was much below the seasonal average, with December the driest on record.

Enjoy with wood-fired pizza, grilled scallops, or baked whole snapper.
