BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Brookland Valley is located along Caves Road, in the heart of the premium wine region of Margaret River, Western Australia. A truly beautiful estate with the Wilyabrup Brook as a breathtaking backdrop to all that Brookland Valley has to offer. The picturesque property spans 52ha, consisting of vineyards established in 1983 planted to Chardonnay, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sauvignon Blanc and Merlot.

TASTING NOTES

Deep red with purple hues, this wine displays wonderful black cherry, blackberry and pomegranate fruit aromas intertwined with exotic spice and white pepper flavours on the bouquet.

It reveals a juicy, fruit driven palate that lingers against a soft acid and refined tannin backbone. This wine will further develop in the bottle for up to five years.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

After harvesting, it was destemmed into static fermenters, before being routinely worked to extract flavour, colour and tannin and pressed off at dryness. The resulting wine underwent malolactic fermentation before being matured with new and seasoned French oak for 12 months.

Enjoy with mild beef curry or Moroccan chicken.
