

HOUGHTON STRIPE SAUVIGNON BLANC SEMILLON 2007



BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Houghton is Western Australia's most awarded winery. Established in 1836, and is the third oldest winery in Australia.

Houghton sources the finest fruit from vineyards in all premium viticultural areas across Western Australia, to craft exceptional wines that truly reflect their regional origins.

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of lifted citrus, passionfruit tropical fruits and delicate herbaceous characters reminiscent of freshly cut hay are at the forefront with a touch of punchy gooseberry fruit derived from the dominant sauvignon blanc component.

The palate is immediately fresh, vibrant and soft with citrus fruit flavours prevailing. A long and satisfying palate balanced by a crisp finish.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Careful winemaking has served to enhance the vibrant citrus fruit and gentle herbaceousness of this wine.

Following cold settling of the juice parcels to obtain clarity, the juices were then racked to fermentation tanks. At the completion of fermentation the wines were clarified, stabilised and blended. The resulting wine was then bottled soon after fermentation to retain all the bright fresh fruit flavours.
